About UDRP

- Uniform Domain-Name Dispute-Resolution Policy
- For biz, .com, .info, .name, .net, and .org
- Typically a trademark rights holder requisites domain name against e.g. cyber squatting registration
- Approved UDRP providers (only 4 worldwide)
- Unified UDRP rules by ICANN and supplementary rules for each provider



CAC as UDRP provider

- First contacts with ICANN in spring 2006
- Formal application filed in January 2007
- Two public consultations during 2007
- ICANN Board has approved on 23 January 2008
- CAC is ADR Provider for .eu related disputes



UDRP implementation

- CAC approved as a new UDRP provider in January 2008
- UDRP implementation by the end of October 2008
- External testing in November 2008
- CAC plans to start accepting UDRP complains in December 08/January 09



Why to file complaints with CAC

- Innovative on-line platform
- Only top IP experts as panellists
- Class Complaint
- Simplified filings



New CAC`s on-line platform

- Pilot project on electronic only UDRP announced by ICANN http://www.icann.org/en/ announcements/announcement-22jul08-en.htm
- Step by step implementation of multiple languages



On-line platform innovation

- Simplified fillings of hardcopies
- Electronic-only UDRP
- Electronic case files
- Master accounts accessible by a single login



Simplified fillings of hardcopies

- No need to send the whole sets of hardcopy Complaint or Response
- To file a Complaint or Response on the on-line platform
- The platform will generate a one-page Form which the Party will sign and send to CAC



Electronic-only UDRP

- For parties which participate in multiple UDRP disputes
- Use of authentication card (Chess Card)
- Strong authentication (user password + one-time generated password)
