## NPIX

- Nepal Internet Exchange established in 2002 with 4 ISPs
  - One location, one switch, I 28kbps aggregate b/w
- Now with 15 members
  - Two Locations, Two switches, ~150Mbps of aggregate b/w

### National Traffic Growth

- Current International bandwidth coming to Nepal is around 3 Gbps.
- And is growing at the rate of 1Gbps every six months.
- The growth explosion happened after providers moved from satellite to cross border fiber 2 years ago. And also after incumbent introduced ADSL services for widespread coverage.

#### **ISP**

- Currently there are 44 ISPs in Nepal and most of them concentrated in capital city Kathmandu.
- Incumbent telecom is the biggest ISP with big retail customer base.
- ISPs are using ADSL, outdoor ethernet cabling,
  WiFi, CATv and Fiber as the last mile technology.
