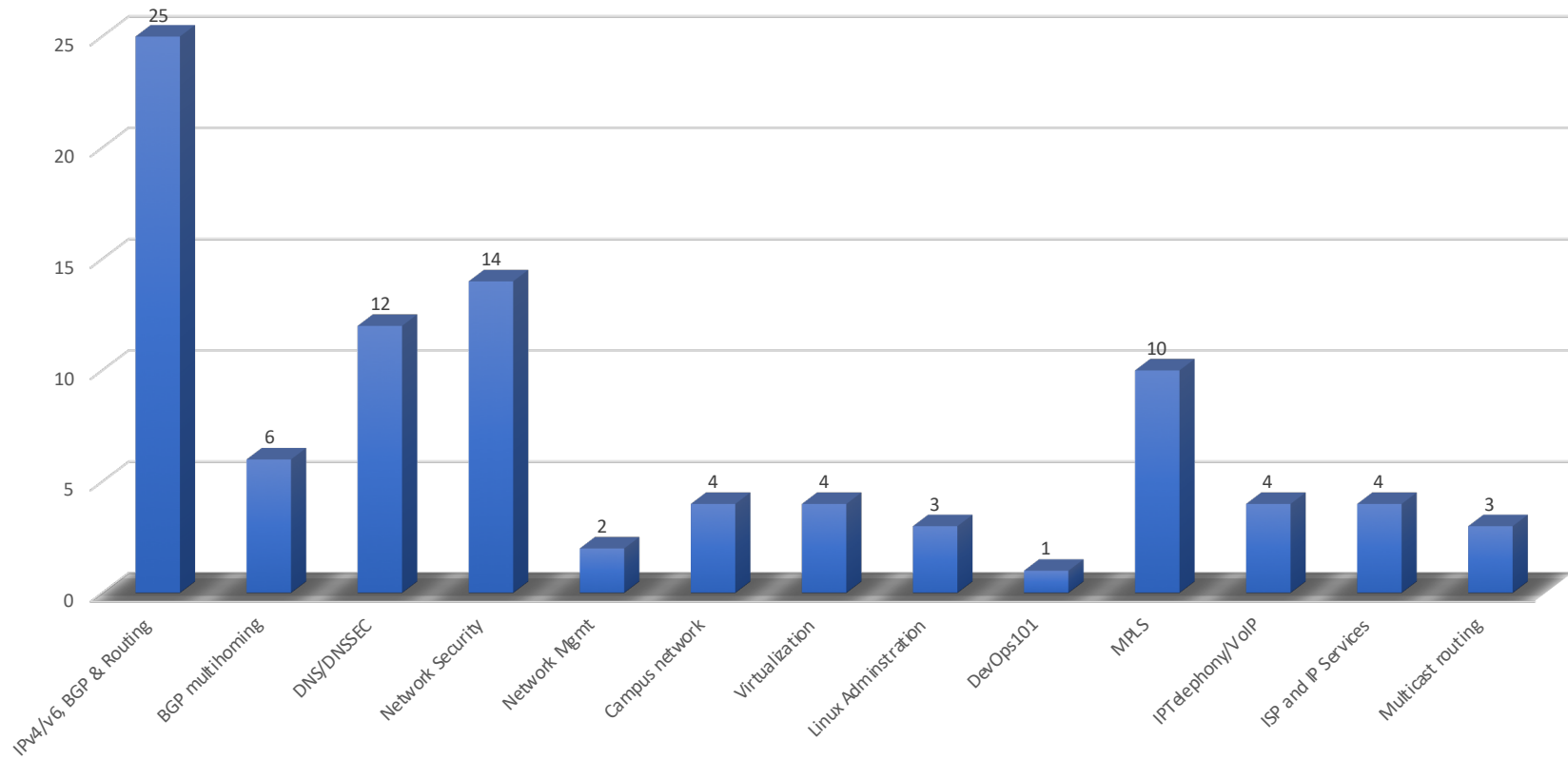

Major Workshop track topics:



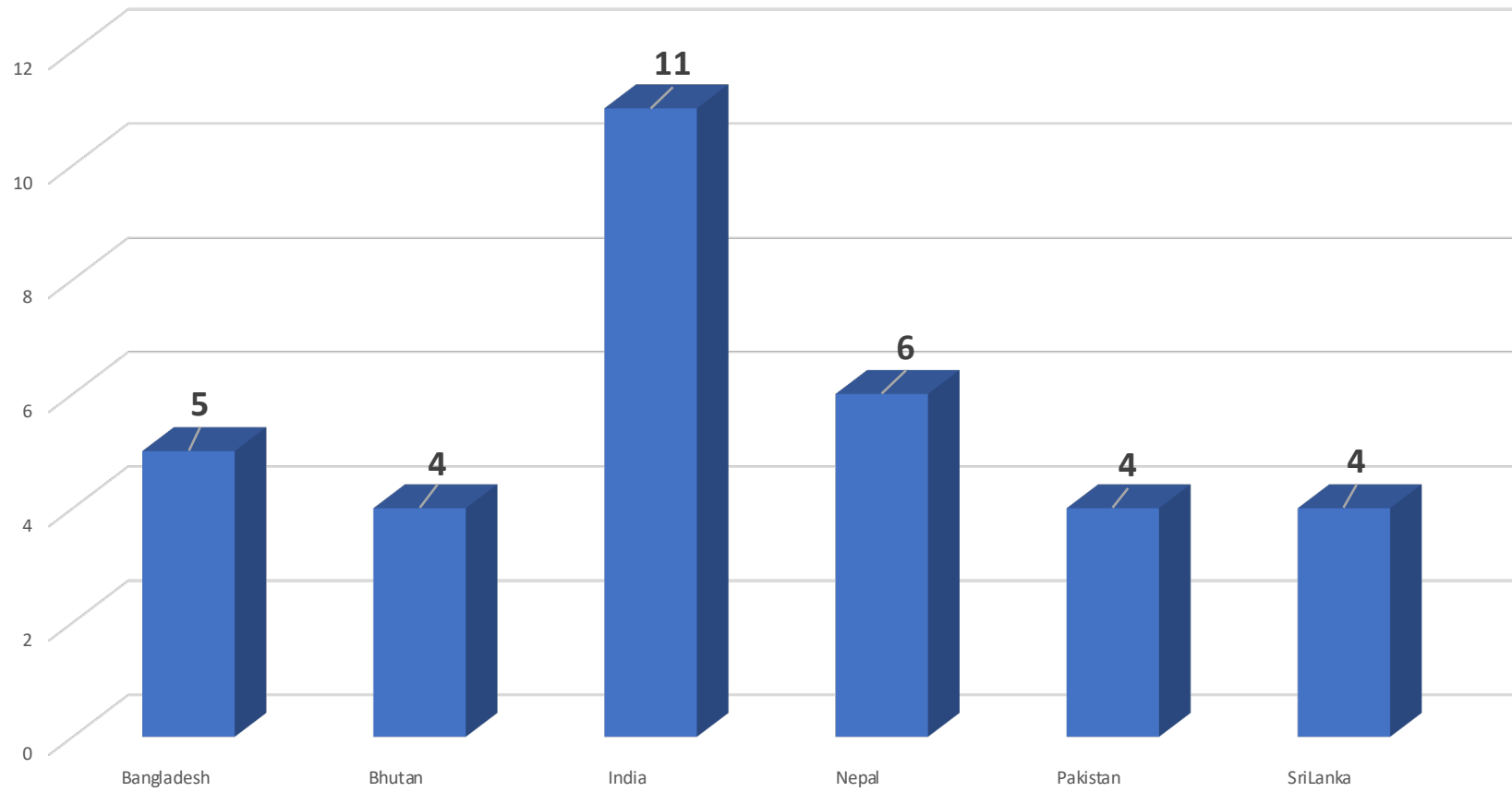
