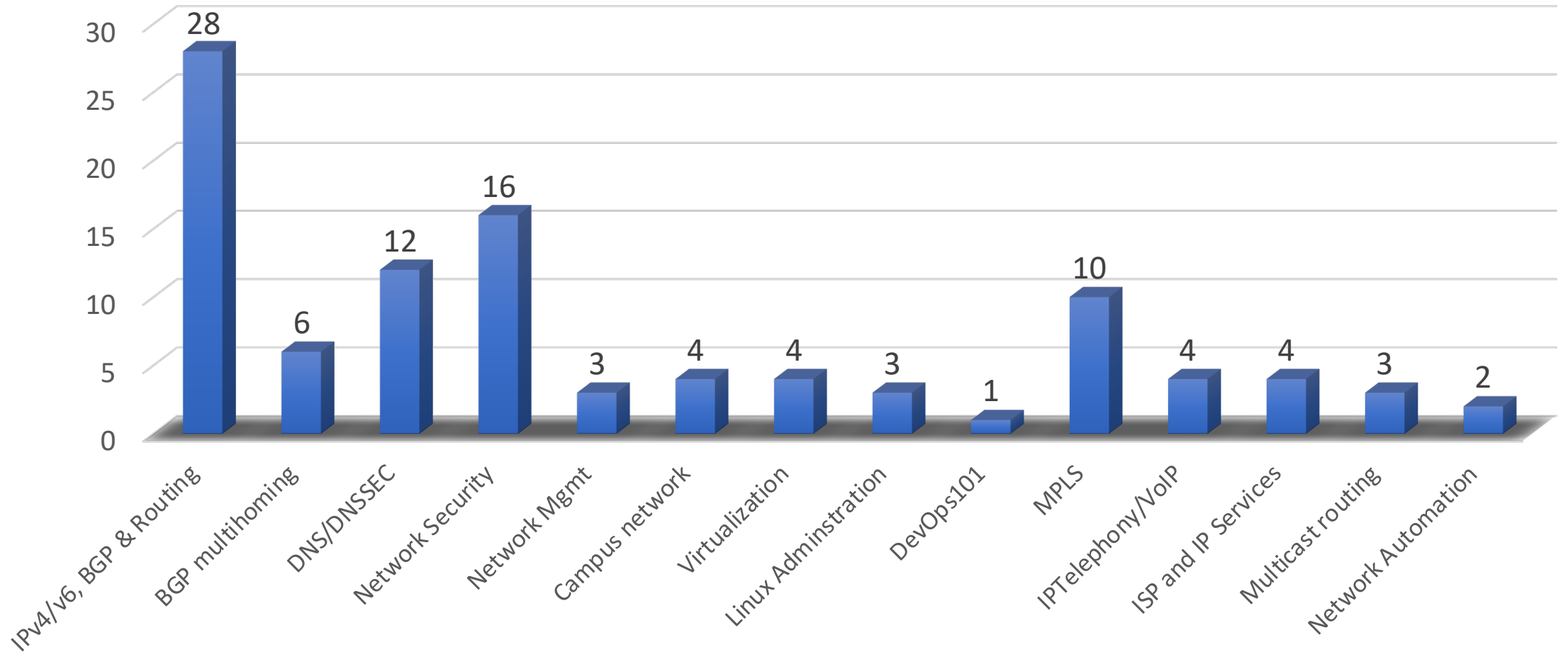

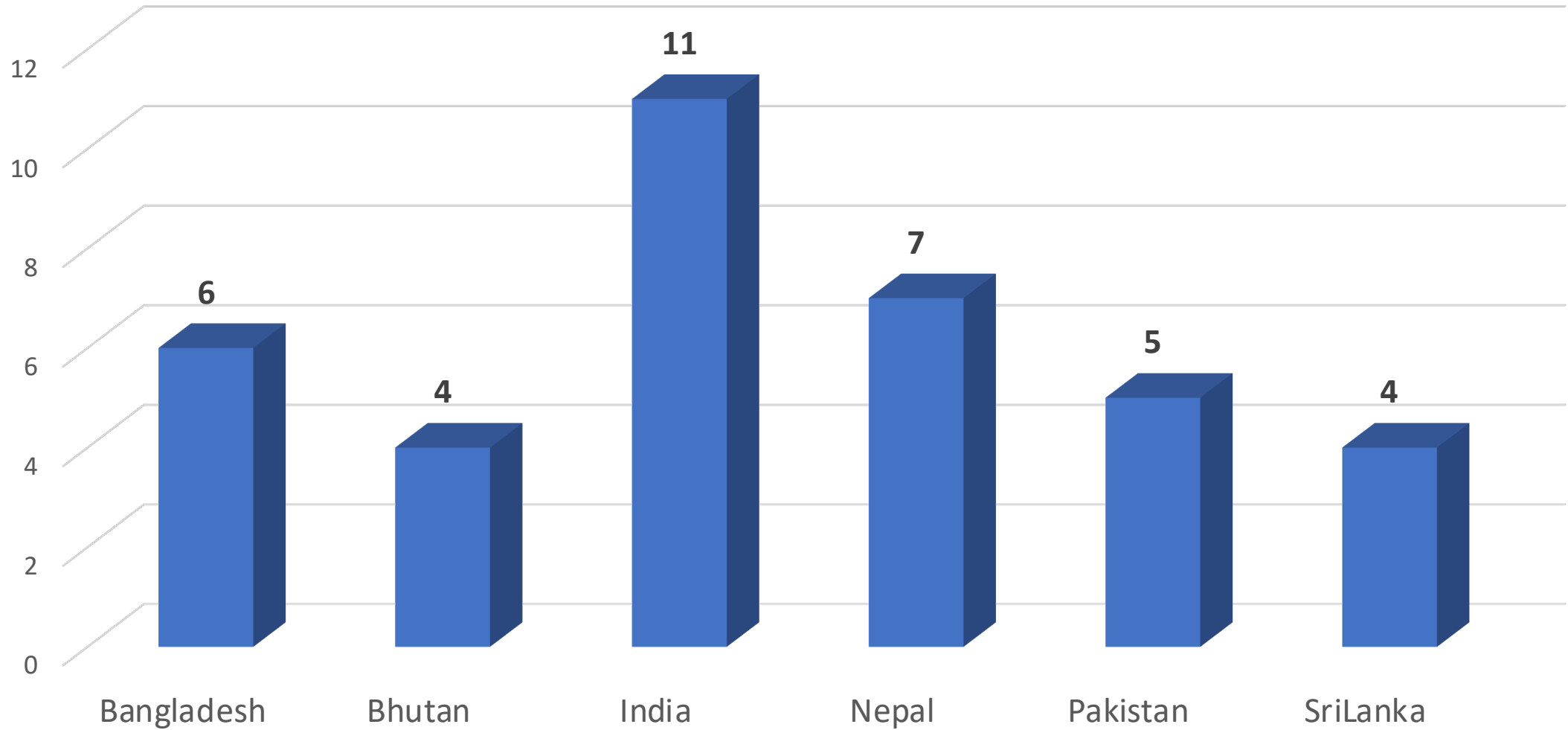

Number of times SANOG hosted- Country wise

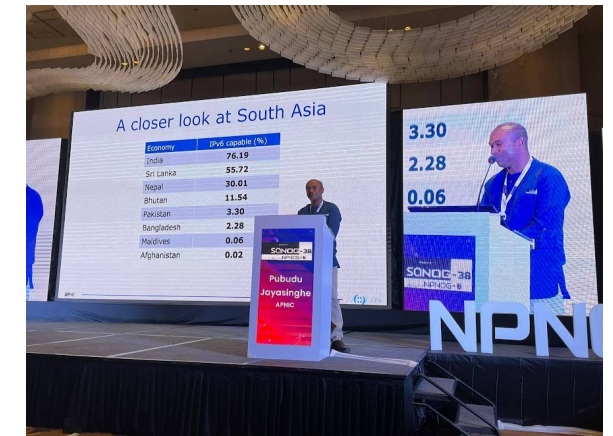

SANOG CERT INITIATIVE- ANNOUNCEMENT



- SANOG is going to bring together CERTS across South Asian countries to build better information flow, communication and co-ordination efforts.
- The SANOG CERT will also build a regional CERT initiative to co-ordinate with Asia Pacific and other CERTs across the region and worldwide for more coordination on behalf of South Asia.
- Will bring in more values for NOG community as well as for enterprises to create a trusted threat sharing platform.
- Timeline:
 1. Initiate further work now will provide update in SANOG-41
 2. Communicate and collaborate with South Asian Certs.
 3. 2024 to mid 2025, SANOG CERT will be threat sharing, collaboration and information platform.
 4. By mid 2025, SANOG will determine whether its resources and network are strong enough to build up as a incident response team or not.
