How do I become an APNIC member?

- Submit the membership application form
- (Request resources if required)
- Sign both copies of membership agreement and post to APNIC
- Pay membership fees
- APNIC signs membership agreement & posts you one copy





How do I get IP resources?

- Become a member
- Check you satisfy criteria
- Complete the request forms





What are the criteria for initial IPv4 allocation?

- Have used a /23 from upstream provider OR Show immediate need for /23
- Detailed plan for use of /22 within 1 year
- Renumber to new space within 1 yea

What are the criteria for initial IPv6 allocation?

- Plan to connect 200 end sites within two years
- Must be an LIR
- Must not be an end user
- Initial allocation size is /32
